Eric Boldt - Warning Coordination Meteorologist, National Weather Service

In his roles as the Warning Coordination Meteorologist for the National Weather Service, Eric Boldt works closely with the City of Los Angeles Emergency Management Department, as well as Emergency Preparedness Coordinators from county, and state governments to provide high impact weather event support and educational needs.

The National Weather Service Office in Oxnard, where Eric works, provides 24/7 weather watch and warning operations for Los Angeles, Ventura, Santa Barbara, and San Luis Obispo Counties. They have supported the City of Los Angeles Emergency Operations Center in multiple activations such as Super Bowl 56, Summit of the Americas, the 2023 January – March Atmospheric Weather Events, and Hurricane/Tropical Storm Hilary.

Eric also does public outreach, media relations, and awareness campaigns. For his efforts to keep our communities safe, BICEPP is pleased to recognize Eric with our Award of Recognition.
