There are 1,969 people currently hospitalized, 27% of these people are confirmed cases in the ICU and 18% are confirmed cases on ventilators.

Five Drive-Through testing sites: Woodland Hills Recreation Center (West Valley), Crenshaw Christian Center, Hansen Dam, Dodger Stadium, and Lincoln Heights Two Walk-in testing sites: 397 tests administered as reported on June 30, 2020. Carbon Health and Kedren Community Health Center Tests administered, as reported on July 7, 2020: 2,036. Grand total: 436,139

Mass Care continues to support 13 shelters, and 7 trailer expansion sites. Recreation and Park's Summer Play LA program will begin July 6, 2020 at all 46 Recreation sites. www.laparks.org

LAUSD will continue to operate its 63 Grab and Go points of distribution with the same operational hours, 0800-1100 until August 14, 2020 Meals served, as reported on July 6, 2020: 386,833. Grand total: 41,781,822

Meals for Angelenos with Disabilities program continuing to provide meals to people in need in coordination with LADOT, Mayor's Office, Department of Disabilities, Mass Care Branch, FNSS and our partners Khalsa Care Foundation and ACCESS Services.

BOC GENERAL UPDATES

During the COVID-19 (Novel Coronavirus), the Business Operations Center (BOC) has assisted the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) with providing critical items towards the response. The BOC continues conversation between our private sectors, Chamber of Commerce, Universities, NGO's and other agencies, and work with council office and Neighborhood Councils.

BOC UPDATES

- Working with the LA Area Chamber to identify critical needs within the business community. BOC is also working with Chamber is providing information and training for Business Resiliency.
- The BOC has been in direct connection with K-12 schools and Colleges/Universities in developing Academic network and providing information in regards to the response.
- Closely collaborating with Department of Public Health liaison in regards to protocols, procedures and other vital information to for the Public/Private Sectors.
- Business Ambassador Program (BAP) is currently active, however in a limited scope. As of July 1, 2020 two businesses have been visited by the BAP program.


