BOC GENERAL UPDATES

During the COVID-19 (Novel Coronavirus), the Business Operations Center (BOC) has assisted the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) with providing critical items towards the response. The BOC continues conversation between our private sectors, Chamber of Commerce, Universities, NGO's and other agencies, and work with council office and Neighborhood Councils.

BOC UPDATES

- Working with the LA Area Chamber to identify critical needs within the business community. BOC is also working with Chamber to identify critical technology needs of the small business community.
- Closely collaborating with Department of Public Health liaison to update the various public/private sectors on changes in public health orders, protocols and procedures.
- Working with the Public Information Officer and Information Technology Agency in developing a BOC website and virtual assistance center.
- Working with Public Information Officer to develop social media content for business readiness, response and recovery for sharing on the City's various platforms.
- BOC updated the City's Business Readiness page with new content which includes: Resuming Business Toolkit Coronavirus Disease 2019; 7 Steps to a Disaster Resilient Workplace; and LAEDC's Guide to Planning for Business Operations After Earthquake.

SECTOR/PARTNER UPDATES

- LA Regional Chamber developed the website OneLA Regional Collaborative. The focus is a public-private partnership that transforms procurement regionally. This collaboration includes the City of Los Angeles Chief of Procurement. The Chamber is working with the State of California in receiving PPE's for small business. This includes receiving, warehousing and distribution to all those who are eligible. The team is working with the County of Los Angeles in designing "seal of approval" process that recognizes companies who are following County COVID-19 protocols in ensuring that their employees and customers are safe.
